## **Fundamental**

Expect futures to extend its upward trust today following overnight gains in U.S. equities market and crude oil strong performance on bets that the major central bank might be approaching the end of its tightening cycle and Beijing's aid stimulates pro-economic actions while intermittent profit taking activities after recent rally might cap gains. Back in the state, U.S. stocks kicked off busy earnings week with mild gains on Monday, with Dow's extended winning streak to 193501 its longest run in six years on optimism over a slew of corporate earnings reports 1921.88 and Fed decision on Wednesday that may signal the end of its interest-rate hikes. Across the region, Asian stock markets were mixed on Monday, as participants braced for an action-packed week of corporate earnings and central bank meetings that will likely see higher interest rates in Europe and the United States, and just possibly the end of the monetary tightening cycle in both. At home, the FBM KLCI climbed higher, extending their gains for third day, underpinned by persistent foreign buying interest in selected index-linked counters notably in financial services due to stronger corporate earnings and improved economic conditions overshadowed mixed regional peers' undertone. The benchmark index

ended at 1,424.69 with gains of 11.17 points, led by the gains in TNB, MAY, CIMB, AXIATA and SDPL shares. Futures to cash basis strengthened to Par from 2.5 points discounts.

## Technical

Futures jumped to three months high after breaching its crucial immediate resistance level at 1,420.0 on the back of strong gains in the underlying cash despite weak regional forces. The July futures contract settled at 1,425.0, with gains of 14 points, forming a long white bodied candlestick pattern with a short upper and short bottom shadow, as bull seized control of the trading session aggressively. Technically, the MACD indicator remains issue a buy signal while RSI lingered at neutral region. Hence, expect futures to continue its buying mode today on the back of resilient overnight Wall Street and crude oil sturdy performance amid optimism that the U.S. Federal Reserve may be nearing the end of its tightening cycle. Therefore, the trading range for today's trading session can be found at 1,415.0 and 1,438.0.

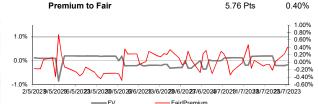
